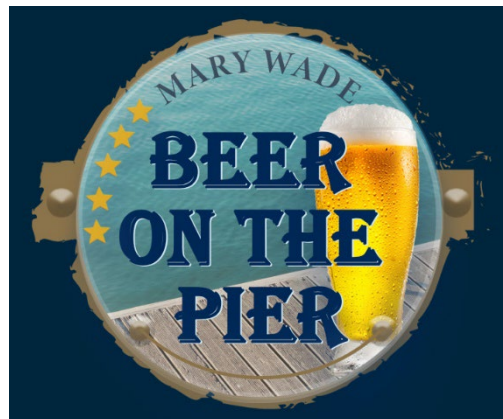


Spring Has Sprung!
