Chatham Place Family Council Meeting



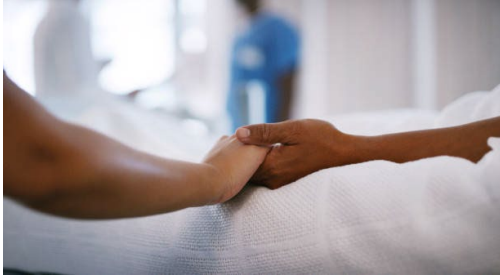
We are pleased to invite families to the upcoming Family Council Meeting at Chatham Place Thursday, **June 18** from 5:00pm to 6:00pm.
